VIDEO SURVEILLANCE ON SCHOOL PROPERTY

POLICY:

The Board of Education (“Board”) is supportive of the use of video surveillance on School District property, facilities, and on school buses.

Video surveillance cameras in a school facility, or on school land, or buses may be installed for the purposes of protecting:

- the safety of individuals in a school facility, on school land, or on a bus;
- an individual’s belongings in a school facility, on school land, or on a bus, or;
- school property.

The use of video surveillance must respect the privacy rights of students and others, providing a safe learning and working environment and the need to protect School District property from theft and vandalism.
