STAFFING

POLICY:

1. The Board of Education (“Board”) is committed to providing a staff of high quality, having good professional qualifications, and high ethical standards. The Board will endeavour to hire the best candidates available and to assign them to appropriate positions.
2. The Board will be responsible for maintaining a staffing policy and ratifying all appointments and transfers.
3. In accordance with section 65 of the [School Act](#), the Board delegates to the Superintendent and/or his/her delegates the power to appoint staff; and the power to discipline, suspend, or dismiss staff except where there is a limitation of that power which is contained in the collective agreement or in the *School Act*.

INFORMATION RELEVANT TO POLICY

Section 65 (2) A Board may:

- (c) delegate specific and general administrative and management duties to one or more of its employees.

8.1 Delegation of Duties and Powers
