



DISTRICT PRACTICE 9100 LOANS TO PARENT ADVISORY COUNCILS

DISTRICT PRACTICE:

1. The Board of Education “Board” may consider a loan to a Parents’ Advisory Council or a school to support a project.
2. The loan will not exceed half the value of the project to a maximum loan of \$10,000.
3. Only one loan will be considered for any school or their Parents’ Advisory Council at a time.
4. The repayment period will be no longer than three years. If a Parents’ Advisory Council were unable to pay off the loan, it will be the responsibility of the school to repay the loan in full.
5. Requests for Board support should be in writing with a full description of the project, its costs, and the methods of fund raising.
6. Goods purchased should comply with Canadian Safety Association (C.S.A.) standards where appropriate.
7. Prior consultation with School District administration is required.
8. The project requires the written support of the school principal.
9. Installation, where required, will be the responsibility of School District personnel.
