To Parents of Students Currently in Grade 5 (Kimberley Zone) Intensive French Program

Rocky Mountain School District is pleased to offer an Intensive French program in the Kimberley Zone for students entering Grade 6 in September 2025. The program was implemented in September 2009 at McKim Middle School.

Parents will be invited to a meeting scheduled for **Tuesday, March 5th at 5:30 pm at McKim.**

The attached parent information package and registration form is being sent for your information. The parent meeting is designed to provide more information and to give you the opportunity to ask questions.

Please Note:

1. **Registration forms are due by noon on Wednesday, March 12th.** You may [register online here](#) OR deliver the paper form to the District Administration Office, fax it to the District Administration Office (250-342-6966) attention: Corinna Koss, or scan and email to corinna.koss@sd6.bc.ca.
2. There is a maximum enrolment of one class of 28 students for this program. Based on a quota, each school will be provided equity of access to the program. If the number of registrants by noon on Wednesday, March 12th exceeds the school quota, there will be a lottery process to determine the students who will be placed in the program.

By holding a lottery for all registrants, this aligns with the District's priority area of equity and inclusion

3. If the class is not full by noon on Wednesday, March 12th, the remaining spots will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis after that date. A wait list will then be created in case any spots become available.
4. It is important to understand that the program will only operate if there is sufficient enrolment. The Board of Education has determined the guideline to be 25 students. If there are less than 25 students, the situation will be assessed by the Superintendent in consultation with the Zone Trustees.
